Friends & Cultures Around the World	The World Around Us / Friends Around the World	Present Simple (he/she), verbs of perception, articles <i>a/an</i>	places, landscapes, climates, countries, traditions, and traditional foods	describing and comparing people/places; talking about habits; giving simple information
2. Detectives & Mysteries	Nate the Great	Past Simple regular, <i>wh</i> -questions (<i>Who? What? Where? When?</i>)	objects, everyday actions, and places in town	telling about a past event; asking and answering questions; giving descriptions
3. Sounds & Rhythms	Zin! Zin! A Violin	Present Continuous, comparatives/superlatives	musical instruments and sounds	describing tools and ongoing actions; talking about preferences
4. Curiosity & Creations	Ada Twist, Scientist / Rosie Revere, Engineer	<i>be going to</i> (future), imperatives with objects and adverbs, <i>because/so</i>	scientific instruments, lab activities, and parts of machines	explaining experiments; giving instructions; describing future projects.
5. Friends & Stories	Frog and Toad Are Friends	Past Simple irregular, sentences with <i>when</i> & <i>because</i>	emotions, seasons, nature, and everyday activities	telling stories; expressing causes and consequences; describing friendships
