Corrected version

*My perfect day is in bed watching TV. I'm **excited** and **relaxed**, but when I stay in bed in the afternoon, I need to do **homework** and I don't like this **thing**.*

Simple corrections & comments

- "in the bed" → "in bed"
We say "in bed" (no *the*) when we talk about sleeping or relaxing.
- "to watch T.V." → "watching TV"
After "is", we use **-ing form**: *watching*.
- "I'm exitid" → "I'm excited" Spelling: *excited* (not *exitid*)
- "relaxing" → "relaxed"
- *Relaxing* = something is relaxing
- *Relaxed* = how you feel
- "home work" → "homework" It's one word.
- "thins" → "thing" Spelling mistake → *thing*
- **Comma**: After *afternoon*, we add a comma to make it clearer.



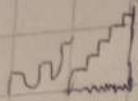

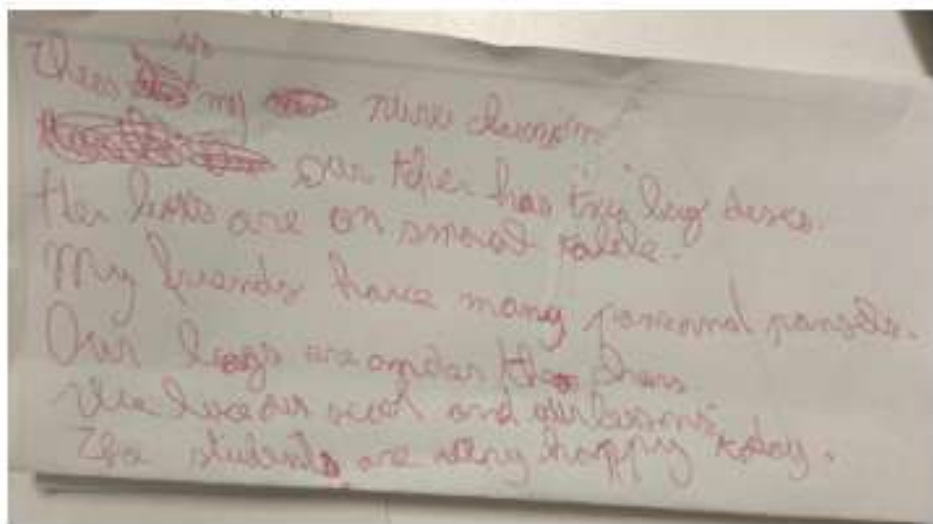

Short Corrections:

- **This (not Thees):** Short sound, we use the letter **i**.
- **Teacher (not Tcher):** Don't forget the **ea** for the long sound.
- **Small (not smaal):** Remember: **all** (like ball and tall).
- **Pens/Pencils:** Watch the vowels: **e** for pens and **i** for pencils.
- **Under (not onder):** In English, the 'uh' sound is usually a **u**.
- **Chairs (not cheirs):** This word has **air** in it. Ch-**airs**.
- **School (not scool):** Add a 'silent' **h** after the **c**.
- **Missing "the":** Remember to add '**the**' before 'small table'.
